As a student of Grace Christian Academy, I commit myself to a high standard of behavior as evidenced in the following:

I desire to grow in obedience to Christ, the knowledge of His Will, and hide God’s Word in my heart:

- Coming prepared to class
- Refraining from the participation in or consumption of anything that will harm my body.

I will show respect to my teachers, the Administrator, and all parent volunteers by my words and actions, and I will obey instructions from the same. I will accept responsibility for my actions and refrain from:

- Disruptive behavior
- Vulgarity/profanity

“Listen to advice and accept instruction, and in the end you will be wise.” (Proverbs 19–20)

I will show appreciation of my teachers’ efforts and time and will be faithful in completing all of my assignments.

- Get work done and handed in on time

I will treat others with kindness and respect. I will refrain from:

- Bullying (verbal, physical or cyber)

I will strive to build bonds of friendship with my fellow students and will not take part in physical or verbal arguments. I will refrain from:

- Physical contact (fighting/aggressive behavior)
- Bullying

“Be kind and compassionate to one another, forgiving each other, just as in Christ God forgave you.” (Ephesians 4:32)

I promise to be truthful and honest. I will refrain from:

- Lying
- Cheating

“Therefore, each of you must put off falsehood and speak truthfully to his neighbor...” (Ephesians 4:25)

I will show respect toward school property, personal property and the building. This includes:

- Stealing
- Defacing property
- Graffiti (inside OR outside of the building)

- All cell phones and electronics must be checked in to the office at the beginning of the school day.
